# ETEM 1 - CHURCH OF GOD IN GUYANA (INCORPORATION) BILL 1974 - Bill No. 19/1974 published 22.6.74. 29.6.74 and and 6.7.74

Mr. Aaron moved the second reading of the following Private Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CHURCH OF GOD IN GUYANA TO HOLD THE PROPERTY IN GUYANA OF THE MISSIONARY BOARD OF THE CHURCH OF GOD AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH.

The motion was put and carried.

The Bill was then read a second time and was, thereafter, taken through its remaining stages and passed as printed.

# ITEM 2 - NATIONAL SCIENCE RESEARCH COUNCIL BILL 1974 - Bill No. 23/1974 published 23.7.74

The Minister of Economic Development moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND INCORPORATION OF THE NATIONAL SCIENCE RESEARCH COUNCIL AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH.

The Leader of the Opposition spoke to the motion.

Thereafter, the Minister of Economic Development replied.

The notion was then put and carried.

The Bill was then read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

#### In Committee

#### Clauses 1 to 12 were passed as printed.

- <u>Clause 14</u> The following amendments by the Leader of the Opposition were put and <u>negatived:</u>
  - (a) <u>Deletion</u> of the words "an auditor appointed by the Council with the approval of the Minister" at the end of subsection (1) and <u>substitution</u> of the words "the Director of Audit" therefor.
  - (b) <u>Deletion</u> of the words "auditor appointed to audit the accounts of the Council under this section" in the second and third lines of subsection (2) and <u>substitution</u> of the words "Director of Audit" therefor.

(c) <u>Deletion</u> of the word "auditor" in the second line of subsection (3) and <u>substitution</u> of the words "Director of Audit" therefor.

Clause 14 was then passed as printed.

<u>Clause 15</u> - The following amendment by the <u>Leader</u> of the Opposition was put and <u>negatived</u>:

<u>Deletion</u> of the word "auditor" in the second line of subsection (2) and <u>substitution</u> of the words "Director of Audit" therefor.

Clause 15 was then passed as printed.

Clauses 16 to 20 were passed as printed.

#### Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Economic Development, the Bill was read the third time and <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.
