 - .(2) Section 2 shall be deemed to have come into operation with respect to and from the year of assessment commencing on lst January, 1970.
 - (3) Section 3 shall come into operation with respect to and from the year of assessmen commencing on 1st January, 1975. **.

Clause 1 was then passed as amended.

Clauses 2 and 3 were passed as printed.
