## Presentation and First Reading

In accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified Cabinet's recommendation and presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

> A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUE FROM THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE SUM NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE (NOT OTHERWISE LAWFULLY CHARGED ON THE CONSOLIDATED FUND) OF GUYANA FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31ST DECEMBER, 1978, ESTIMATES WHEREOF HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, AND FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF THAT SUM FOR SPECIFIED PURPOSES, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE CONSTITUTION.

#### Second and Third Readings

On motions by the Minister of Finance, the Bill was read a second and the third times and <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.
