MOTIONS

ITEM 1 - APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL PAPER NO. 1/1978

Assembly resolved itself into Committee of Supply to consider Financial Paper No. 1/1978.

In Committee of Supply

In accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified Cabinet's recommendation and moved the following motion:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Committee of Supply approve of the proposals set out in Financial Paper No. 1/1978 - Schedule of Supplementary Provision on the Current and Capital Estimates (Advances made from the Contingencies Fund in 1977) for the period ended 31st December, 1977, totalling \$13,159,040.

After consideration of the Financial Paper, the motion was put and carried.

Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Finance, the Assembly adopted the following Resolution:

RESOLVED, That this National Assembly agree with the Committee of Supply in the following Resolution:

"RESOLVED, That the Committee of Supply approve of the proposals set out in Financial Paper No. 1/1978 - Schedule of Supplementary Provision on the Current and Capital Estimates (Advances made from the Contingencies Fund in 1977) for the period ended 31st December, 1977, totalling \$13,159,040."

ITEM 2 - INCREASE IN LIABILITY OF GOVERNMENT IN RESPECT OF GUARANTEES

The Minister of Finance moved the following motion:

WHEREAS in accordance with section 3(1) of the Guarantee of Loans (Public Corporations and Companies) Act, Chapter 77:01, the Government may in such manner and such terms and subject to such conditions as may be agreed between it and a lending agency •

- (a) guarantee the discharge by a Corporation of its obligations under any agreement which may be entered into by the Corporation with a a lending agency in respect of any borrowing by that Corporation that is authorised by the Government;
- (b) assume such other obligations as may be agreed between the Government and a lending agency in relation to or pursuant to any such agreement;
- (c) undertake the repayment to a lending agency of such sums as the landing agency may have advanced to or for the benefit of the Government:

AND WHEREAS it is provided under section 4(1) of the aforesaid Act, that the aggregate amount of the liability of the Government in respect of guarantees given under section 3 of the Act shall not at any time exceed the sum of two hundred million dollars or such greater sum as may from time to time be specified by the Resolution of the National Assembly:

AND WHEREAS it has become necessary to specify in accordance with the said section 4(1) a greater sum for the purpose of enabling the aggregate amount of liability of the Government in respect of guarantees to be increased due to the 1978-1981 Development Programme for those incorporated bodies to which the Act applied:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly approve that the aggregate amount of the liability of the Government under section 4 (1) of the Guarantee of Loans (Public Corporations and Companies) Act, in respect of guarantees given under section 3 of the Act, shall not at any time exceed the sum of five hundred million dollars.
