The Speaker informed the Assembly that he had received a letter dated 23rd May, 1978, from Cde. Lallbachan Lalbahadur tendering his resignation as a Member of the National Assembly. Following Cde. Lalbahadur resignation, a seat had become vacant in the Assembly. In accordance with article 70 (1) of the Constitution, he had called upon the Representative of the People's Progressive Party List of Candidates to further extract from the said List the name of a person to fill the vacancy. The name Parag Sukhai had been extracted from the List and Cde. Sukhai had been declared to be elected a member of the National Assembly.

Cde. Sukhai, who was present, made and subscribed as a Member of the National Assembly, the Oath of Office as required by article 76 of the Constitution.

DECLARATION OF RESULTS OF REFERENDUM BY THE SPEAKER OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

Under section 99 of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 1:03 of the Laws of Guyana. as modified by the Referendum (Modification of the Representation of the People Act) Regulations 1973, the Speaker of the National Assembly is required to publicly declare the results of the Referendum as soon as practicable after Referendum Day.

The Referendum was held on Monday, 10th July, 1978. The question to which the electors were asked to answer either "Yes" or "No" was "Do you approve of the Constitution (Amendment) Bill 1978, which was passed by the National Assembly on 10th April, 1978, and published in the Official Gazette dated 13th May, 1978?".

The results of the Referendum have been submitted to me by the Chief Election Officer and I now publicly declare them.

The number of valid votes cast for the question was — 419,936

In the circumstances, I hereby declare that the Constitution (Amendment) Bill No. 8 of 1978 has been approved by a majority of the electors who voted on the Bill in accordance with article 73(3) of the Constitution.
