MOTION

ITEM 2 - ESTABLISHMENT OF CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY

The Prime Minister moved the following motion:

WHEREAS the people of Guyana are entitled as of right to enjoy the highest possible standard of living and quality of life consistent with their work and the development of the country's resources;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid right cannot be assured unless the society and the economy are reconstructed on socialist principles;

AND WHEREAS the existing Constitution is not a suitable vehicle for effecting the necessary reconstruction of the society and the economy of the State;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to adopt a new Constitution designed to ensure social and economic justice for all of the people of Guyana:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly resolves itself into a Committee consisting of all the members of the Assembly (including the Speaker) to be known as a Constituent Assembly for the purpose of preparing a new Constitution for the Republic of Guyana, provided that members of the National Assembly who are not elected members of the National Assembly shall be entitled to participate in the proceedings of the Constituent Assembly but without the right to vote thereat;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Constituent Assembly shall have power ${\color{red} \sim}$

- (a) to elect its Chairman and a Deputy Chairman from among persons who are members of the Constituent Assembly;
- (b) to appoint the Secretary of the Constituent Assembly and such other staff which may be considered requisite by the Constituent Assembly for the carrying out of its functions;
- (c) to delegate to the chairman the powers conferred by paragraph (b), other than the power to appoint the Secretary;
- (d) to co-opt permanent advisory delegations representing other groups of persons in the society, in particular, the Guyana Association of Local Authorities, the Trades Union Congress and religious organisations, to assist the Constituent Assembly in its deliberations in the preparation of the new Constitution for the Republic of Guyana;

- (e) to invite and receive memoranda from members of the public or from organisations and to take evidence from persons desiring to testify before it;
- (f) to hold meetings in any part of Guyana; and
- (g) to regulate its own procedure.

The Prime Minister was speaking to the motion when the time for the adjournment of the sitting was reached.

SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDER NO. 9(1)

On a motion by the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs and Leader of the House Standing Order No. 9(1) was suspended to permit the sitting to continue beyond 10 o'clock.

The Prime Minister concluded his speech.

The Leader of the Opposition spoke to the motion and moved the following amendments:-

(i) To the original motion:

Addition of the following after paragraph (g):

"AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the draft Constitution prepared by the Constituent Assembly be approved not by the National Assembly but on a referendum to be conducted under the following conditions:

- (a) that the Elections Commission be in full charge of the conduct and administrative arrangement of the referendum including preparation of a new Voters Register;
- (b) that the United Nations Human Rights Committee be invited to observe the referendum;
- (c) that the results of the referendum be subject to judicial review by the Supreme Court."

(ii) To his amendment at (i) above:

Insertion of the words "or an election" between
the words "referendum" and "to".

The Prime Minister replied.
