The Speaker stated that he was informed of the following changes:-

DEPENDANTS' PENSION (AMENDMENT) BILL 1978 - BILL NO. 17/1978 published 11.8.78

The Minister of Finance, on behalf of the Government, presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE WIDOWS AND ORPHANS PENSION ACT TO EXTEND THE CATEGORIES OF CONTRIBUT 25 TO THE NEW WIDOWS AND ORPHANS! FUND (INCLUDING FEMALES, IN PARTICULAR), TO ALLOW FOR CHILDREN BORN OUT OF WEDLOCK TO BENEFIT FROM THE FUND, TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 73 THEREOF, AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH.
