The Deputy Speaker informed the Assembly that a letter had been received from Cde. Lyttleton E. Ramsahoye tendering his resignation as a Member of the National Assembly with effect from 1st September, 1978, to enable him to take up an appointment as Director of Research at the Caribbean Meteorological Institute in Barbados. Following Cde. Ramsahoye's resignation, a seat had become vacant in the Assembly. The representative of the list from which Cde. Ramsahoye's name had been extracted had been called upon to further extract from the list the name of a person to fill the vacancy. The name of Cde. Abdul Salim had been extracted from the list and Cde. Salim had been declared to be elected a member of the National Assembly.

Cde. Salim, who was present, made and subscribed as a Member of the National Assembly, the Oath of Office as required by article 76 of the Constitution.

The Minister of Health, Housing and Labour, on behalf of the Government, presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO REPEAL AND, WITH CERTAIN AMENDMENTS, RE-ENACT THE LABOUR (CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN WORKERS) ACT, CHAPTER 99:03, REGULATING THE CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT OF CERTAIN WORKERS. The Attorney General and Minister of Justice, on behalf of the Government, presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

> A BILL intituled AN ACT TO ALTER CHAPTER VII OF THE CONSTITUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 73 THEREOF AND TO MAKE PROVISION FOR MATTERS RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE.

(4) MEDEX BILL 1978 - Bill No. 21/1978

The Minister of Health, Housing and Labour, on behalf of the Government, presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

- A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF PERSONS AS MEDEX FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING PRIMARY HEALTH CARE AS AUXILIARIES TO MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS EMPLOYED IN THE SERVICE OF THE GOVERNMENT.

MOTIONS

ITEM 1 - DEATH OF PRESIDENT OF REPUBLIC OF KENYA

The Prime Minister moved the following motion:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly records its deep regret at the death of President Jomo Kenyatta of the Republic of Kenya, and directs that an expression of its sympathy be conveyed to his sorrowing relatives and to the Government and People of the Republic of Kenya.

Cde. J. Jagan and Mr. Abraham spoke to the motion.

The motion was then put and <u>carried</u> with Members standing.

The Minister of Finance moved the following motion:

WHEREAS the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and other financial institutions, organisations and agencies are lending agencies within the meaning of the State Enterprises (Guarantee) Act, Chapter 77:03;

AND WHEREAS the Caribbean Development Bank is a regional institution within the meaning of the State Enterprises (Guarantee) Act, Chapter 77:03;

AND WHEREAS the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and other lending agencies lend funds to the Caribbean Development Bank for onlending to Guyana or to any state Enterprise, on a guarantee given by the Government of Guyana:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly approve of the giving of any guarantee by the Minister of Finance or such other person duly authorised by him, acting on behalf of the Government of Guyana, for the repayment to any such lending agency of funds lent to the Caribbean Development Bank by the lending agency for on-lending to G_uyana or to any State Enterprise for development projects, within the limit permitted under section 3(1) of the External Loans Act, Chapter 74:08.

Cde. N. Persaud spoke to the motion.

The Minister of Finance was replying to the motion when the time for the suspension of the sitting was reached.

The Deputy Speaker informed the Assembly that it was agreed that the sitting would not be suspended until the debate on the motion was completed

The Minister of Finance concluded his reply.

The motion was put and carried.

ADJOURNMENT

At 4.13 p.m., on a motion by the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs and Leader of the House, the Assembly was adjourned to a date to be fixed.
