PUBLIC BUSINESS

BILL - Second and Third Readings

ITEM 1 - CONSUMPTION TAX BILL, 1969 - BILL NO. 13/1969 published 19.6.69

In terms of article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified the Cabinet's recommendation and moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A CONSUMPTION TAX ON GOODS IMPORTED INTO GUYANA OR MANUFACTURED THEREIN, FOR THE COLLECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SUCH TAX, AND FOR MATTERS INCIDENTAL THERETO OR CONNECTED THEREWITH.

Mr. Ram Karran spoke to the motion.

The Minister of Finance replied.

Therefafter, the question was put and carried.

The Bill was then read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

In Committee

Clause 1: The following amendment by the Minister of Finance was put and carried:

Deletion of Clause 1 and the <u>substitution</u> of the following clause -

"Short 1. This Act may be cited as title the Consumption Tax Act, 1969 and shall be deemed to have commence-ment. May, 1969."

Clause 1 was then passed as amended.

Clauses 2 and 3 were passed as printed.

Clause 4: The following amendment by the Minister of Finance was put and carried:

Renumbering of Clause 4 as subsection (1) and addition of the following subsection immediately thereafter:-

" (2) Any order made under this section may take effect from a date earlier than the date on which the order is published in the Gazette, not being a date prior to the commencement of this Act. "

Clause 4 was then passed as amended.

Clauses 5 to 27 were passed as printed.

The Schedule was passed as printed.

Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Finance, the Bill was read the third time and passed as amended in Committee.

ADJOURNMENT

At 3.10 p.m. on a motion by the Minister of Trade and Parliamentary Affairs, the Assembly was adjourned to 2.00 p.m. on Monday, 30th June, 1969.
