Assembly resolved itself into Committee of Supply.

## In Committee of Supply

In terms of article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified the Cabinet's recommendation and moved the following motion which was put and <u>carried</u>:

#### BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Committee of Supply approve of the proposals set out in Financial Paper No. 6/1969 - Schedule of Supplementary Provision on the Current and Capital Estimates for the period ending 30th June, 1969, totalling \$5,220,984.

#### Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Finance the Assembly adopted the following Resolution:-

RESOLVED, That this National Assembly agree with the Committee of Supply in the following Resolution:

"RESOLVED, That the Committee of Supply approve of the proposals set out in Financial Paper No. 6/1969 - Schedule of Supplementary Provision on the Current and Capital Estimates for the period ending 30th June, 1969, totalling \$5,220,984."

## ILLNESS OF THE LEADER OF THE OPPOSITION

Before the adjournment was taken, His Honour the Speaker commented on the reports in the newspapers concerning the illness of the Leader of the Opposition, Dr. C.B. Jagan, and, after expressing regret on behalf of the Assembly, enquired of Mr. Ram Karran whether he was in a position to tell the Assembly something about the Leader of the Opposition.

Mr. Ram Karran informed the Assembly that a cable was received by Mrs. Jagan (wife of the Leader of the Opposition) requesting that she and her daughter should be in Moscow as early as possible. The cable followed a letter written earlier by Dr. Jagan informing his wife of his plan to undergo medical treatment and requesting her and their daughter's presence. However, since the cable was erroneously date-lined New York, Mrs. Jagan cabled Moscow to ascertain its accuracy.

She then received a reply from Mr. R. Chandisingh, confirming the message of the first cable, and as a result, herself and daughter flew out to Moscow.

His Honour the Speaker on hearing this requested Mr. Ram Karran to convey to the Leader of the Opposition the Assembly's concern over his illness and its best wishes for his speedy recovery.

At 5.00 p.m., on a motion by the Minister of Trade and Parliamentary Affairs, the Assembly was adjourned to a date to be fixed.
