INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL ORGANISATIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1969 - Bill No. 21/1969

The Minister of Finance on behalf of the Government presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL ORGANISATIONS ACT, 1966, AND TO MAKE CERTAIN CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS TO THE BANK OF GUYANA ORDINANCE, 1965.

ITEM 1 - RICE MARKETING (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1969 - Bill No. 20/1969 published 28.8.69

Assembly resumed consideration of the following mill in Committee:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE RICE MARKETING ORDINANCE, TO DISSOLVE THE GUYANA RICE DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, LIMITED, AND TO MAKE MINOR AMENDMENTS TO THE GUYANA RICE PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION ORDINANCE.

In Committee

Clauses 11 to 19 were passed as printed.

Assembly resumed

On a motion by the Minister of Finance the Bill was read a third time and passed as amended in Committee.

MOTION

TTEM 2 - MOTION TO WRITE-OFF AMOUNTS OWED TO GOVERNMENT BY THE GUYANA RICE DEVELOPMENT COMPANY AND THE GUYANA RICE MARKETING BOARD

The Minister of Finance, in accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, signified the Cabinet's recommendation and moved the following motion:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly approve of the writeoff of the amounts owed as follows:-

- (a) By the Guyana Rice Development Company:
 - (i) Two million, four hundred and eightyseven thousand eight hundred and eightyfive dollars (\$2,487,885.00) being part
 payment, by the Government of capital
 \$2,...,000.00 and interest \$87,885.00,
 on account of loan owing to the
 Commonwealth Development Corporation
 by the Guyana Rice Development Company;
 - (ii) Two million one hundred and thirty-six thousand dollars (\$2,136,000.00) being the balance of capital owing on the aforesaid loan which has been refinanced by the Government with effect from the 1st day of October, 1967; and
 - (iii) One million eight hundred thrusand dollars (\$1,800,000.00) being overdraft loans owing to the Commercial Banks by the Guyana Rice Development Company and refinanced by the Government with effect from 14th day of June, 1968.
- (b) By the Guyana Rice Marketing Board:

Two million nine hundred and three thousand and seventy-five dollars and twenty-nine cents (\$2,903,075.29) being part of the capital amount owed by the Rice Marketing Board to the Government with interest thereon from 14th June, 1968.

Mr. Ram Karran and Mr. Balchand Persaud spoke to the motion.
Thereafter, the Minister of Finance replied.

The motion was then put and carried.

REMARKS OF APPRECIATION

Before the adjournment was taken, the Hon. Minister of Trade and Parliamentary Affairs informed the Assembly that the appointment of the Acting Deputy Clerk of the National Assembly, Mr. Ronald H. Fraser, would terminate at that sitting. He therefore, on behalf of the Assembly, placed on record the deep appreciation of the very fine manner in which Mr. Fraser had carried out his duties during the four months of his acting appointment.
