ITEM 1 - LOCAL AUTHORITIES (ELECTIONS) BILL, 1969 -Bill No. 23/1969 published 3. 10. 69

Assembly resumed the debate on the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES, FOR THE PREPARATION OF ELECTORAL REGISTERS FOR THE PURPOSES OF SUCH ELECTIONS, FOR THE DETERMINATION OF DISPUTES IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH ELECTIONS AND OF DISPUTES IN CONNECTION WITH ELECTIONS TO CERTAIN OFFICES IN LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND FOR MATTERS INCIDENTAL TO AND CONNECTED WITH THE AFORESAID PURPOSES.

The Leader of the Opposition concluded his speech. Thereafter, the Minister of Local Government replied. The motion was then put and <u>carried</u>. The Bill was read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

Clause 1 was passed as printed.

<u>Clause 2</u> - The following amendment by the Minister of Local Government was put and <u>carried</u>:

> <u>Deletion</u> of the definition of "registration officer" and <u>substitution</u> therefor of the following definition:

> > "registration officer" means -

(a) an electoral registrar;
(b) a deputy registrar;
(c) an assistant electoral registrar;

Clause 2 was then passed as amended.

<u>Clause 3</u> - The following amendment by Mr. Ram Karran was put and negatived:

Deletion of subsection (2).

Clause 3 was then passed as printed.

Clause 4 was passed as printed.

<u>Clause 5</u> - The following amendment by the Minister of Local Government was put and <u>carried</u>:

> In subsection (1) the insertion immediately after the word "such" in the second line, of the words "deputy registrars".

Clauses 6 to 11 were passed as printed.

<u>Clause 12</u> - The following amendment by the Minister of Local Government was put and <u>carried</u>:

> In subsection (1) the deletion of the the words "by reason that he is not a person qualified to be registered by virtue of a residential qualification" from sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (b).

The following amendment by Mr. M.F. Singh was put and negatived:

In subsection (2) the deletion of the words "three dollars" and the <u>sub-</u> <u>stitution</u> therefor of the words "fifty cents" in the second line.

Clause 12 was then passed as amended.

Clauses 13 and 14 were passed as printed.

<u>Clause 15</u> - The following amendment by Mr. Ram Karran was put and <u>negatived</u>:

> In subsection (3) the <u>insertion</u>, immediately after the word "card" in the second line, of the words and comma "if any, or an affidavit supporting his claim," and the deletion of the comma and words ", or the assistant electoral registrar is otherwise satisfied as to the identity of the applicant".

Clause 15 was then passed as printed.

Clauses 16 and 17 were passed as printed.

<u>Clause 18</u> - The following amendment by Mr. Ram Karran was put and <u>negatived</u>:

In subsection (1) the <u>insertion</u> of the following immediately after "(iii)" of paragraph (b):

" (iv) Representative of political parties reasonably expected to contest the elections and members of the press;" and the renumbering of "(iv)" and "(v)" as "(v)" and "(vi)" respectively.

Clause 18 was then passed as printed.

<u>Clause 19</u> - The following amendment by Mr. Ram Karran was put and negatived:

> Insertion of the words and commas ", if any," between the words "card" and "of" in the fourth line of paragraph (a).

Clause 19 was then passed as printed.

<u>Clause 20</u> - The following amendments by the Minister of Local Government were put and <u>carried</u>:

- (i) In subsection (3) the <u>deletion</u> of the words and comma "any person on behalf of whom the objection or application is made," in the second line.
- (ii) <u>Insertion</u> of the following as subsection (9):

"(9) A deputy registrar shall, if directed by the Minister so to do, hear and determine objections and applications lodged under section 12, and he shall, for such purposes have all the powers of an electoral registrar under this section. "

The following amendment by Mr. Chandisingh was put and <u>negatived</u>:

In subsection (2) the <u>insertion</u> of the words and commas "in all the daily newspapers, giving at least seven days notice," between the words "publish" and "a" in the first line of paragraph (a).
