# ITEM 1 - INCOME TAX (IN AID OF INDUSTRY) (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1969 - Bill No. 27/1969 published 15.11.69

## TITEM 2 - CARIBBEAN DEVELOPMENT BANK AGREEMENT BILL, 1969 - Bill No. 28/1969 published 17. 11. 69
