MOTION

ITEM 1 - MOTION TO APPROVE ESTIMATES OF EXPENDITURE FOR 1971

BILLS - Second and Third Readings

ITEM 2 - CORPORATION TAX BILL, 1970 - Bill No. 29/1970 published 5.12.70

In accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance signified the Cabinet's recommendation and moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO IMPOSE A TAX ON THE PROFITS OF COMPANIES AND FOR PURPOSES CONNECTED THEREWITH.

Mr. M.F. Singh and the Leader of the Opposition spoke to the motion.

SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDER NO. 9(1)

Just before 10.00 p.m., on a motion by the Minister of Education (Leader of the House), Standing Order No. 9(1) was suspended to enable the Assembly to sit until items 2 and 3 on the Order Paper had been disposed of.

The Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance replied to the motion for the second reading of the CORPORATION TAX BILL, 1970.

The action was then put and carried.

The Bill was read a second time, and was, thereafter, taken through its remaining stages and passed as printed.

ITEM 3 - INCOME TAX (AMENDMENT NO. 2) BILL, 1970 - Bill No. 30/1970 published 5.12.70

In accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance signified the Cabinet's recommendation and moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE INCOME TAX ORDINANCE.

The motion was put and carried.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

In Committee

Clauses 1 to 15 were passed as printed.

Recommittal of Clause 15

On a motion by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance Clause 15 was recommitted.

The following amendment by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance was put and carried:

Deletion of the word and figures "or 41" from the new section 41A.

Clause 15 was then passed as amended.

Clause 16 - The following amendment by the Deputy
Prime Minister and Minister of Finance
was put and carried:

Deletion of paragraph (b) from subsection (4) of the new section 47A and relettering of paragraph (c) as (b).

Clause 16 was then passed as amended.

Clauses 17 to 24 were passed as printed.

The Schedule was passed as printed.

Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance the Billwas read a third time and passed as amended in Committee.

At 11.05 p.m., on a motion by the Minister of Education (Leader of the House), the Assembly was adjourned to 2.00 p.m. on Thursday, the 10th of December, 1970.
