Dr. Ramsahoye moved the following amandment:

Insertion of the following as paragraph (7) of
regulation 3 of the Regulations in the Sixth
Schedule:

" (7) No information obtained pursuant to the provisions of this regulation may be used otherwise than for purposes of proceedings under this Ordinance. "

After discussion, Dr. Ramsahoye withdrew the amendment, and moved the following amendment which was put and <u>carried</u>:

Insertion of the words "in proceedings under this Ordinance" between the words "him" and "notwithstanding" in paragraph (4) of regulation 3 of the Regulations in the Sixth Schedule.

Clause 8 was then passed as amended.

Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Finance, the Bill was read the third time and <u>passed</u> as <u>amended in Committee</u>.
