INTRODUCTION OF BILLS -

Presentation and First Reading

APPROPRIATION BILL 1971 - Bill No. 27/1971 published 29.12.71

The Minister of Finance, on behalf of the Government, presented the following Bill which was read the first time:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUE FROM THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE SUM NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE (NOT OTHERWISE LAWFULLY CHARGED ON THE CONSOLIDATED FUND) OF GUYANA FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31ST DECEMBER, 1972, ESTIMATES WHEREOF HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, AND FOR APPROPRIATION OF THAT SUM FOR SPECIFIED PURPOSE, IN CONFORMITY WITH THE CONSTITUTION.

PUBLIC BUSINESS

MOTION

ITEM 1 - MOTION TO CONFIRM CUSTOMS DUTIES (EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTIES) (NO. 31) ORDER, 1971

The Minister of Finance moved the following motion which was put and carried:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly, in terms of section 9 of the Customs Ordinance, Chapter 309, confirm the Customs Duties (Exemption from Import Duties) (No. 31) Order, 1971 (No. 80), which was made on the 3rd of December, 1971, and published in the Gazette on the 11th of December, 1971.

BILLS - Second and Third Readings

ITEM 2 - MISCELLANEOUS (FISCAL ENACTMENTS) (AMENDMENT) BILL 1971 - Bill No. 26/1971 published 17,12.71

The Cabinet's recommendation having been signified, the Minister of Finance moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND CERTAIN FISCAL ENACTMENTS.

Mr. Sutton and Dr. Ramsahoye spoke to the motion.

Thereafter, the Minister of Finance replied.

The motion was then put and carried.

The Bill was read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

In Committee

Clauses 1 and 2 were passed as printed.

Clause 3 - The following amendment by the Minister of Finance was put and <u>carried</u>:

<u>Substitution</u> of a colon for the full stop at the end of the clause and insertion of the following proviso -

"Provided that -

- (a) the increase in the corporation tax imposed by the foregoing provisions of this section shall not apply to a company which satisfies the Commissioner of Inland Revenue that the company would not have been liable for the payment of withholding tax pursuant to section 27B of the Income Tax Ordinance if that section had been in operation during the period commencing on 1st January, 1970 and ending on 11th December, 1970;
- (b) any amount received by the Commissioner of Inland Revenue from a company as withholding tax pursuant to section 27B of the Income Tax Ordinance during the year 1970 shall be set off against the increase in the corporation tax payable by virtue of the foregoing provisions of this section.".

Clause 3 was then passed as amended.

Clause 4 was passed as printed.

<u>Schedule</u>. (1) The following amendment by Mr. M.F. Singh was put and <u>negatived</u>:

Addition of the words "or arising to the individual from any trade, business, profession or vocation" after the words "past services" at the end of the amendment to section 16 of the Income Tax Ordinance, Chapter 299.

(2) Dr. Ramsahoye moved the following amendment:

Renumbering of "(b)" as "(e)", and insertion of the following as "(b)", "(c)" and "(d)" in the amendment to section 19B of the Income Tax Ordinance, Chapter 299:

- " (b) Delete expression "has after the 31st December, 1964"
 - (c) Insert the words "occupied or" after the word "building" where it first appears
 - (d) Delete the word "new" where it first appears. "

The amendment was under consideration when the time for the suspension of the sitting was reached.

Assembly resumed.

- (4) The following amendment by the Minister of Finance was put and <u>carried</u>:
 - Insertion of the following provisions to
 the amendments to the Corporation Tax
 Act 1970 -
 - "Section 6(2) The words "in the year preceding" shall be substituted for the word "for". "

On a motion by the Minister of Finance, the Bill was read a third time and passed as <u>amended</u> in <u>Committee</u>.

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO REGULATE THE AWARDS OF STATE PENSIONS IN RESPECT OF SERVICE TO THE STATE IN CERTAIN SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

Mr. D.C. Jagan, Mr. M.F. Singh, Mr. Ram Karran and the Leader of the Opposition spoke to the motion.

Thereafter, the Minister of Finance replied.

The motion was then put and carried.

The Bill was thereafter read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill clause by clause.

Clauses 1 to 3 were passed as printed.

Clause 4 - (1) Mr. Ram Karran moved the following amendment:
