# Item 1 - ELECTRICITY (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1968 -Bill No. 4/1968 published 12.2.68

Item 2 - TAX (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1968 -Bill No. 5/1968 published 12.2.68

On a motion by the Minister of Finance, the following BILL was read a second time:

> A BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE TAX ORDINANCE

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the BILL clause by clause.

#### In Committee

Clauses 1 to 3 were passed as printed.

#### Assembly resumed.

The Minister of Finance then signified the Cabinet's recommendation and moved that the Bill be read the third time and passed as printed.

## Item 3 - WRECKS REMOVAL (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1968 -Bill No. 3/1968 published 27.1.68

On a motion by the Minister of Communications, the BILL intituled AN ACT TO AMEND THE WRECKS REMOVAL ORDINANCE was read a second time and was thereafter taken through its remaining stages and <u>passed</u> as printed.
