The Minister of Natural Resources moved and the Minister of Labour, Health and Housing seconded that the BILL intituled AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BRITISH GUIANA RICE HRODUCERS ASSOCIATION ORDINANCE be read a second time.

That this Council recommends to Government the withdrawal of preferential treatment to the British West Indian Airways and the establishment of Atkinson Field as a port of call for as many airlines as may wish to call there.
