Item 1 - INCOME TAX AME

On a motion by the Minister of itself into Committee to resume conside ation of the BILL intituled AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE INC ME TAX ORDINANCE.

In Committee

Clause 3 - The Minister of Finance m ved the following further amendment to para aph (e) which was put and carried:

Insertion of the followi after sub-paragraph
(v) of the new section (2 (c):

"(vi) the realisation by a liquidator of the assets of a compan in liquidation for the purpose of the dissolution of the company and return of the proceeds of the realisation to the shareholders of the company;"

Clause 3 as amended was then put and carried.

With the leave of Committee, Clause was recommitted to allow Mr. d'Aguiar to move the followin amendment to paragraph (e) which was put and negatived:

Deletion of the following in the new section (2)(d)(i):

", and the value of the roperty at the time when it was acquired as aforesaid by such person shall be an amo t equal to the market value of the pro erty on 1st January, 1956".

Thereafter, Clause 3 as amended was ut and carried.

Clause 4 was under consid ration when the hour for the suspension was re ched.

Suspension of Sitting

<u>Clauses 4 and 5</u> - were passed as inted.

- <u>Clause 6</u> The <u>Minister of Finance</u> oved the following amendments to the new sec ion 66(C)(2), which were put and carried:
 - (i) <u>Insertion</u> of the word "aforesaid" between the words "the" and "emoluments" in the fourth and tenth li s of the first proviso.
 - (ii) Substitution of the w d "assessable" for "accessable" in the elfth line of the second proviso.

Thereafter, Clause 6 as amended was put and carried.

- <u>Clause 7</u> The <u>Minister of Finance</u> m ed the following amendments to the new sec ion 69(A) which were put and carried:
 - (i) <u>Deletion</u> of the word "only" between the words "shall" and "be" i the fifth line of subsection (6).
 - (ii) <u>Insertion</u> of the word "only" between the words "binding" and "in" in the fifth line of subsection (6).
 - (iii) Substitution of the wo ds "such other" for the word "any" at t commencement of subsection (8)(m).
 - (iv) <u>Deletion</u> of the word "fficial" between the words "the" and "Ga ette" in the second line of subsection 8)(m).
 - (v) Substitution of the wo d "of" for the word "or" between the wo ds "certificate" and "identity" in the f urth line of subsection (10).
 - (vi) Substitution of the wo ds "pursuance of" for the words "pursuant to" in the fifth line of subsection (11).
 - (vii) <u>Insertion</u> of the words "or leave" between the words "enter" a d "British Guiana" in the sixth line o subsection (13).

Thereafter, Clause 7 as amended was p t and carried.

Clauses 8 to 11 - were passed as prin ed.

Assembly resumed.
