QUESTIONS TO MINISTERS

QUESTION NO. 19.

<u>Mr. Blair</u> asked the Minister of Labour, Health and Housing the following question:-

- Question: Will the Minis er of Labour, Health and Housing state -
 - (a) how many visits were made by each of the Dispensers stationed at Schepmoed and Ida Sabina, Berbice River, to each of the points usually visited by them during the half year ending July 31, 1963?

- (b) how many times di the Infant Welfare and Maternity League hold the usual Clinic at each point in the Berbice River where it is usually held, during the same period?
- (c) according to the Schedule of visits, how many should have been made by -
 - (i) each of the dispensers, (ii) the nurse

during the same period?

The <u>Minister of Labour, Health and Housing</u> gave the following reply:-

- Answer: (a) 15 visits were made by the Dispenser at Schepmoed and 11 visits by he Dispenser, Ida Sabina.
 - (b) 22 clinics were held in the Schepmoed district. No clinics as such were held in the Ida Sabina district, but the nurse at Ida Sabina attended to cases who came to Ida Sabina.
 - (c) (i) By Dispenser, Schepmoed Dispensary -24 By Dispe ser, Ida Sabina -22
 - (ii) By Nurse, Ida Sabina By Nurses, Schepmoed area -No fixed number

of clinics.
