# ITEM 4 - DEEDS REGISTRY AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) BILL 2007 – Bill No. 22/2007 published on 2007-10-24

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT to amend the Deeds Registry Authority Act. (Read a first time on 2007-11-01)

The following Members spoke to the motion: Mrs. Clarissa Riehl Mr. Khemraj Ramjattan Thereafter the Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs replied.

The Bill was then read a second time.

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs moved the following amendments which were put and carried:

- (a) Insert immediately after the word "amended" the words "-(a)"
- (b) in subsection (4) for the words "subsections (2) and" substitute the word "subsection" and immediately after the word "Registry" insert the words "other than the Registrar and Deputy Registrar".

Clause 3 was then passed as amended.

On a motion by the Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, the Deeds Registry Authority (Amendment) Bill 2007 – Bill No. 22 of 2007 was read a third time and passed as amended.
