Clause 2(c):

Insert immediately after the word 'residence' the following words 'and at the office of the Leader of the Opposition to be provided by the Guyana Police Force';

Clause 2(d):

Delete the words 'a secretary or an executive secretary, a chauffeur' and replace by inserting after the words 'the services of' the words 'a research assistant, an executive assistant/secretary, a clerical/office assistant, a chauffeur, a personal security officer, a gardener and two domestic servants'

Clause 2(e):

Delete this clause and insert a new Clause 2(e) with the words 'salary, vacation allowance, and parliamentary benefits equivalent to those of a Cabinet Minister.'

Clause 2 was then passed as amended.

Clause 3

The Minister of Finance moved the following amendments, which were <u>put</u> and <u>carried</u>

<u>Clause 3(2):</u>

Delete this clause.

<u>Clause 3(3)</u>:

Clause 3(3) to be renumbered 3(2).

Clause 3 was then <u>passed</u> as <u>amended</u>.
