Resignation of Mr. Richard Allen

The Speaker informed Members that he had received from Mr. Richard Allen a letter dated 3rd April, 2013, resigning his seat as a Member of Parliament with effect from that date.

With Mr. Allen's resignation, a seat in the National Assembly became vacant.

The vacancy was, in accordance with section 99A of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 1:03, to be filled by a person whose name was to be extracted from the list of candidates from which Mr. Allen's name was extracted.

As Mr. Allen's name was extracted from A Partnership For National Unity List of Candidates, the Speaker had, in accordance with section 99A of the said Act, called upon the Representative of the said list to further extract from that list the name of a person, who was willing to become a Member of the National Assembly, to fill the vacancy in the Assembly.

OATH OF A NEW MEMBER-

Ms Rennita Lolita Williams

The Speaker informed Members that following the resignation of Mr. Richard Allen, and his call upon the Representative of A Partnership For National Unity List of Candidates, the Speaker had been informed that the name of Ms Rennita Lolita Williams was extracted from the list and that Ms Williams was on the 9th April, 2013, declared to be an elected Member of the National Assembly.

The Speaker stated that before Ms Williams could take part in the proceedings of the Assembly, she would have to make and subscribe the oath of office, as required by Article 167 of the Constitution.

As Ms Williams was present, the oath was administered to her by the Clerk.

Final Rites for Pandat Reepu Daman Persaud, O.R.

Final rites and cremation will take place at the Good Hope Crematorium, I believe, at 1.00 p.m."
