He was informed that the name of Cyrilda Alandia DeJesus had been extracted and that Mrs. DeJesus was, on 13th June, 1994, declared to be an elected Member of the National Assembly to fill the vacancy.

The Speaker said that before Mrs. DeJesus could take part in the proceedings of the Assembly, she would have, as required by article 167 of the Constitution, to make and subscribe the oath of office.

ITEM 4 - AMENDMENT OF STANDING ORDERS

Assembly resumed the debate on the following motion:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Standing Orders of the National Assembly be amended by the insertion of the following as Standing Order No. 70A:-

"70(A). Standing Committees

(1) The Committee of Selection may establish and appoint as many Standing Committees as it considers necessary.

(2) A Standing Committee shall consist of such Members of the Assembly and such other persons as the Committee of Selection shall determine and shall appoint.

(3) The constitution of, procedure in and other matters concerning, Standing Committees shall be as provided for in respect of Select Committees of the Assembly."

Mr. Arthur Alexander spoke to the motion. The Senior Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House) replied.

The motion was then <u>put</u> and <u>carried</u> with the correction of the following typographical error:-

Deletion of the words "and such other persons" from paragraph (2) of the new Standing Order No. 70A.

ITEM 5 - APPROVAL OF NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION PLAN
