 from the Ministry of Finance
 as my be nominated by the
 Minister;"

Clause 18

Deletion of the words "or vice versa" and the words "from the Authority or the Government as the case may be, with, or in connection with, which he was last employed" in Subsection (2).

Clauses 19 to 21 were passed as printed.

Clause 22

The following amendment by the Senior Minister of Finance was $\underline{\mathtt{put}}$ and $\mathtt{carried:-}$

Substitution of the following for subsection (5):-

"(5) The Governing Board shall
determine such officers of
the Departments as shall be
entitled to attend and
participate in deliberations
of any meeting of the Governing
Board without the right to vote.".

Clause 31
