# OATH OF A NEW MEMBER

## Dr. Abraham A.C. Fung-A-Fat, A.A., M.P.

The Speaker announced that following the resignation of Dr. Kenneth F.S. King as a Member of the National Assembly with effect from 1st January, 1997, and his call upon the representative of the list of candidates in which Dr. King's name was included, he was informed that the name of Dr. Abraham A.C. Fung-A-Fat, A.A., had been extracted from the said list and that Dr. Fung-A-Fat was, on 6th March, 1997, declared to be an elected Member of the National Assembly to fill the vacancy.

The Speaker stated that before Dr. Fung-A-Fat could take part in the proceedings of the Assembly, he would have, as required by article 167 of the Constitution, to make and subscribe the oath of office.

As Dr. Fung-A-Fat was present, the oath was administered to him by the Clerk.

## ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE SPEAKER

### (i) Assumption of Office of President by Prime Minister

The Speaker stated that following the death on 6th March, 1997, of Dr. Cheddi Jagan, President of Guyana, the Prime Minister, the Hon. Samuel A. Hinds, had assumed the Office of the President in accordance with article 95 of the Constitution.

Mr. Hinds had ceased to be a Member of the National Assembly and had vacated his seat in the Assembly.

The vacancy in the Assembly had to be filled by a person whose name is to be extracted from the list of candidates in which Mr. Hinds' name was included, i.e., the People's Progressive Party/Civic List, by the representative or, in his inability to do so, by the deputy representative, of the said list.

As Dr. Jagan was the representative of that list, the Speaker informed the Assembly that he had, in accordance with section 99A of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 1:03, called upon the deputy representative of the list, to extract from that list, the name of a person to fill the vacancy in the Assembly.

## (ii) Appointment of Hon. Janet Jagan as Prime Minister and First Vice-President

The Speaker stated that with the assumption of the office of President, Mr. Samuel Hinds ceased to be Prime Minister and that that office had become vacant.

The Speaker said that he was informed that Mrs. Jagan, O.E., an elected Member of the National Assembly, was appointed Prime Minister and First Vice-President with effect from 17th March, 1997.

## (iii) Appointment of Hon. Reepu Daman Persaud as Second Vice-President

The Speaker announced that he was informed that the Hon. Reepu Daman Persaud, Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), had been appointed Second Vice-President.

## (iv) Appointment of Mr. Dunstan Barrow as Chief Whip

The Speaker stated that he was informed that the Minority Leader had appointed Mr. Dunstan Barrow to be Chief Whip.

# (v) Congratulations

The Speaker extended Congratulations and best wishes to His Excellency Mr. Samuel Hinds, the Hon. Janet Jagan, the Hon. Reepu Daman Persaud and Mr. Dunstan Barrow on their elevation to the new Offices.

He also congratulated Dr. Abraham Fung-A-Fat on his election as a Member of the National Assembly. He welcomed Dr. Fung-A-Fat to the Assembly and extended best wishes to him.
