# Second Reading

The Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), on behalf of the Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT to effect changes in the names of Timehri International Airport and Timehri Aerodrome.

(Read a first time on 17.4.97)

The Minority Leader spoke to the motion. (Thereafter, the Members of the People's National Congress withdrew from the Chamber).

The following Members spoke to the motion:

The Parliamentary Secretary, Ministry of Local Government Dr. Rupert Roopnaraine The Minister in the Ministry of Local Government (Hon. F. Vibert DeSouza) Mr. Manzoor Nadir.

Thereafter, the Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House) replied.

The motion was then put and carried.

The Bill was read a second time.

Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill Clause by Clause.

#### In Committee

<u>Clause 1</u> was <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.

# Clause 2

The following amendment by the Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House) was <u>put</u> and <u>carried</u>;

Insertion of the words "on or" between the words "time" and "after" in the fifth line of subsection (1) Clause 2 was passed as amended.

Clause 3 was passed as printed.

Assembly resumed. Third Reading

On a motion by the Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), the Timehri International Airport (Change of Name) Bill 1997 was read the third time and <u>passed</u> as <u>amended</u>.

ITEM 2 - LAND REGISTRY (AMENDMENT) BILL 1997 - Bill No. 3/1997 published 11.4.97

Second Reading

The Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), on behalf of the Attorney-General and Minister of Legal Affairs, moved the second reading of the following Bill:

> A BILL intituled AN ACT to amend the Land Registry Act.

(Read a first time on 17.4.97)

Dr. Rupert Roopnaraine spoke to the motion. The motion was then <u>put</u> and <u>carried</u>. The Bill was read a second time. Assembly resolved itself into Committee to consider the Bill Clause by Clause.

In Committee

Clause 1 was passed as printed.

### Clause 2

Dr. Roopnaraine moved the following amendment:-

<u>Deletion</u> of the words after the word "may" in the proviso to the new subsection (2) to be inserted, and

Substitution of the following therefor:-

"waive, with reasons stated and on the grounds of poverty, or in respect of lands to be devoted entirely to the relief of the poor, or of victims of abuse, to education or religious purposes, or for any other good cause, waive all, or any part of the cost of the said surveys and plans."

The Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House) moved an amendment for Dr. Roopnaraine's amendment to read as follows:

"for reasons stated and on grounds including the relief of the poor or victims of abuse, the promotion of education or religion or any other good cause, waive all, or any part of the cost of the said surveys or plans."

The amendment by the Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), was put and carried.

Clause 2 was passed as amended.

# Assembly resumed.

### Third Reading

On a motion by the Second Vice-President and Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), the Land Registry (Amendment) Bill 1997 was read the third time and <u>passed</u> as <u>amended</u>.
