ITEM 2 - APPROPRIATION BILL 1998 - Bill No. 4/1998 published 7.4.98

With the leave of the Speaker, and on a motion by the Minister of Agriculture and Parliamentary Affairs, Standing Orders Nos. 12 and 46 were suspended to enable the Appropriation Bill 1998 to be introduced at this stage and to be further proceeded with at that sitting.

On motions by the Minister of Agriculture and Parliamentary Affairs, the following Bill was introduced and was read the first, second and third times and <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>:-

A BILL intituled AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the financial year ending 31st December, 1998, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of those sums for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

At 2.20 p.m., on a motion by the Minister of Agriculture and Parliamentary Affairs, the Assembly was adjourned to a date to be fixed.
