The Speaker further stated that he had, in accordance with section 99A of the Representation of the People Act, Chapter 1:03, called upon the representative of the list of candidates from which Mr. Jagdeo's name was extracted, to further extract from the said list, the name of a person to fill the vacancy in the Assembly.
