APPROVAL OF ESTIMATES OF EXPENDITURE FOR 1986

In Committee of Supply

Objection to the format of the Estimates of Expenditure

On a point of order, the Deputy Speaker referred to article 165(1) of the Constitution (Regulation of Procedure) and stated that in terms of Standing Order No. 65(1), the details of the Estimates of Expenditure were inadequate to permit the Committee of Supply to properly consider the Heads of Expenditure. This view was supported by Mr. Kwayana.

The Speaker after listening to remarks by the Vice-President, First Deputy Prime Minister and Attorney General, ruled that the format of the Estimates of Expenditure was in order.
