ITEM 1. GENERAL ELECTIONS (OBSERVERS) BILL 1990 - Bill No. 20/1990 <u>published 1990-06-01</u>

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs moved the second reading of the following Bill:

> A Bill intituled An Act empowering the President of Guyana to invite observers at general elections and for matters connected therewith.

The Deputy Speaker, Mr. Kwayana, and Cde. Collymore spoke to the motion.

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs was replying when the time for the suspension of the sitting was reached.

#### IN COMMITTEE

Clause 3 The Deputy Speaker moved the following amendment.

Addition of the following as subsection (3):

"(3) Notwithstanding subsection (1), it shall be lawfulfor any person from outside of Guyana, at the invitation of the Minority Leader or anyone or more of the Parties contesting the election, to attend and observe the conduct of registration and election and such person shall enjoy similar rights, privileges and immunities as any person invited pursuant to subsection (1)".
