# 1. EQUAL RIGHTS BILL 1990 - Bill No. 5/1990 published 1990-03-17

The Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A Bill intituled An Act to make provision for the enforcement of the principles enshrined in article 29 of the Constitution so as to secure equality for women and for matters connected therewith.

Cdes. Jamet Jagan, Melville, Amma Ally and Mr. Kwayana spoke to the motion. The Vice-President, Culture and Social Development and Deputy Prime Minister was speaking to the motion when the time for the Suspension of the Sitting was reached.

At 4.00 p.m. the sitting was suspended for refreshments.

#### RESUMPTION

At 4.28 p.m. the sitting was resumed.

The Vice-President, Minister of Culture and Social Development and Deputy Prime Minister continued and concluded her speech.

PENSIONS ACT, Cap. 27:02

Pages 28 and 29 Section 22 column 2 paragraph (6)

Substitute -

- \*(6) For subsection (1) (v)
  substitute the following --
  - "(1)(v) if the deceased officer does not leave a spouse, or if no pension is granted to that officer's spouse, and if that officer's mother or father or both were wholly or mainly dependent on him or her for support, a pension to the mother or father or both, while without adequate means of support, of an amount not exceeding the pension which might have been granted to that officer's spouse, such pension being equally divided between the mother and father where payable to both;" ";

Page 29

paragraph (7) Substitute -

"(7) Delete subsection (1) (vi).";

MUNICIPAL AND DISTRICT COUNCILS ACT, Cap. 28:01

Pages 31 and 32 Section 85(1) column 2 Page 32

- (a) For the word "parent" in the three places where it occurs substitute the words "parents or parent as the case may be";
- (b) For the full stop at the end substitute a colon and insert the following proviso -

"Provided that where payment is to be made to the parents of the officer the sum to be paid shall be equally divided between them.";

Page 33 column 2 Section 89(1)

For the word "parent" substitute the words "parents or parent as the case may be".

The Schedule was then passed as amended.

#### ASSEMBLY RESUMED

On a motion by the Attorney General and Minister of Legal Affairs, the Bill was read a third time and passed as amended in Committee.
