* "Amendment of section 2 of the Principal Act. 1A. (1) Section 2 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "value" of the **following definition** -

> "value" in sections 3, 4, 5, and 6 means that cost of production of the locally manufactured goods, excluding the cost of packaging material, labels and caps.

(2) This section shall be deemed to have come into operation on 15th July, 1992",
