## ITEM 2 RICE (REGULATION OF MANUFACTURING AND MARKETING) BILL 1984 -Bill No. 17/1984 published 1984-11-24

The Deputy Prime Minister, Planning on behalf of the Prime Minister moved the second reading of the following Bill:

> A Bill intituled An Act to make provisions for the regulation of the manufacture and marketing of rice, for securing the further development of rice industry, for the establishment of the National Fadi and Rice Grading Centre, the Guyana Rice Milling and Marketing Authority and the Guyana Rice Export Board, and for matters connected therewith.

Cde. Reepu Damar Persaud spoke to the motion.

Thereafter the Prime Minister replied.

The motion was put and carried.

The Bill was read a second time.

Clause 92 (Page 50)

<u>Substitution</u> of the word "carrying" for the word "carry" in the third line of **the proviso** to subsection (10).

Clause 93 (Page 50)

<u>Substitution</u> of the words "The Guyana Rice Board Act" for the words "The Guyana Board Act" in the first line.

Clause 94 (Page 50)

<u>Insertion</u> of the word "case" between the words "the" and "may" in the last line.

#### Assembly resumed


On a motion by the Prime Minister, the bill was read the third time and <u>passed</u> as <u>corrected</u> in Committee.
