Clause 1 was passed as printed.

 $\underline{\text{Clause 2}}$ The following amendment by Mr. Kwayana was put and and $\underline{\text{negatived.}}$

<u>Insertion</u> of the following paragraph after paragraph (0) after subsection (1):

"provisional licence" means a guarantee given to an individual who applies for a production licence that he will be granted a production licence on satisfying the Minister that production under that licence will be undertaken by a corporate entity registered in Guyana.

Clause 2 was then <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u>.

Clause 3 to 8 were passed as printed.

<u>Clause 9</u> The following amendment by Mr. Kwayana was put and <u>negatived</u>.

<u>Insertion</u> of the following subsections after subsection (3):

- (4) That in the case of an application for a licence by a company incorporated outside of Guyana a provisional licence shall be granted and the licence should be granted only to a corporate entity incorporated or registered in Guyana for the purpose of receiving and undertaking production under such provisional licence.
- (5) that companies established under the previous subsection shall be open to participation by both resident and nonresident shareholders.

Clause 9 was then passed as printed.

Clause 10 The Deputy Speaker moved the following amendment which was put and negatived:

Deletion of paragraph (d).

Clause 10 was then passed as printed.

Clauses 11 to 35 were passed as printed.

Clause 36 The following amendment by Mr. Kwayana was put and negatived:

<u>Insertion</u> of the following after paragraph (vii) of subsection (1):

"(viii) the applicant undertakes if the issue arises to recognise a trade union in conditions satisfactory to the Ministry of Manpower and the Trades Union Congress."

Clause 36 was then passed as printed.

Clauses 37 to 50 were passed as printed.

<u>Clauses 51</u> The following amendment by the Deputy Speaker was put and <u>carried:</u>

<u>Substitution</u> of the word "affirmative" for the word "negative" in the second line of subsection (1).

Clause 51 was then passed as amennded.

Clauses 52 to 71 were passed as printed.

Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Deputy Frime Minister, Planning and Development, the Bill was read the third time and passed as amended in Committee.

ITEM 3 - OFF-SHORE BANKING BILL 1986 - Bill No. 4/1986 published 1986-03-15

A Bill intituled An Act to enable certain banking and other businesses to be carried on from within Guyana in foreign moneys, securities and properties for foreign customers.

ITEM 4 - BANKING LAWS (AMENDMENT) BILL 1986 - Bill No. 5/1986 published 1986-03-15

The Minister of Finance moved the second reading of the following Bill:

A Bill intituled An Act to amend the Banking Act and the Bank of Guyana Act.

Mr. Kwayana spoke to the motion.

Thereafter the Minister of Finance replied.

The motion was put and carried.

The Bill was read a second time and was, thereafter, taken through its remaining stages and <u>passed</u> as <u>printed</u> with the following corrections:

Page 4 - Clause 2

- (i) <u>Substitution</u> of the word "or" for the word "of" in the seventh line and in the last lines of subsection (6).
- (ii) <u>Insertion</u> of the words "capital, in the case of a licensed company" between the words "assigned" and "incorporated" in the fourth line of subsection (7).
- (iii) <u>Substitution</u> of the word "or" for the word "of" in the sixth line of subsection (8).
- (iv) <u>Substitution</u> of a semi-colon for the full stop at the end of subsection (9).

Page 5 - Clause 3

- (i) <u>Substitution</u> of "Companies Act," for "companies Act," In the second line of paragraph (b).
- (ii) <u>Substitution</u> of the word "Bank" for the word "bank" in the ninth line of the new subsection 1A) of paragraph (c), where it appears for the first time.

Tage 5 - Clause 4

 $\underline{\underline{Substitution}}$ of the word "sections" for the word "section" in the marginal note.

Fage 6 - Clause 6

- (i) <u>Insertion</u> of a comma after the word "insertion" in the second line.
- (ii) <u>Deletion</u> of the bracket before the word "Part" in the marginal note to the new section 40A.
