**NOTICE**

In accordance with section 2(1) of the National Parks Commission Act 1977, after consultation with the Mayor and City Council of Georgetown, I hereby declare the area known as the Botanic Gardens and described in the Schedule as a designated park.

**SCHEDULE**

**THE BOTANIC GARDENS**

That area of land known as the Botanic Gardens, being a portion of Government Land, situated at the Backlands of Plantation Vlissengen, in the City of Georgetown, in the Republic of Guyana, with buildings and infrastructure, thereon, and defined on a plan by R. O. H. Spence, Government Surveyor, dated 23.05.1905 and recorded in the Department of Lands and Surveys as Plan No. 1462, save and except the Presidential Residence Compound and the Nursery, Horticultural, and Meteorological Station Compounds.

The Botanic Gardens are bounded as follows:

| On the North: | by the southern edge of the Lamaha Canal.                       |
| On the East:  | by the west boundary of the Kitty Avenue Road Reserve.          |
| On the South: | by the northern edge of the trench north of Homestretch Avenue. |
| On the West:  | by the eastern edge of trench east of Vlissengen Road.          |

The said area containing 105 acres and shown on DLS Plan No. 1462 by R. O. H. Spence, Government Surveyor dated 23.05.1905 and site Plan No. X348, recorded in the Department of Lands and Surveys.
