THE KEEPING OF ANIMALS**

1. The notice shall be on wood or metal, of a size not less than eighteen (18) in width and twelve (12) inches in height, with words in black on a white background, maintained in legible state.
2. The notice shall be displayed at a height between five (5) and six (6) feet above the floor level on the entrance of the premises, easily visible from the approach to the entrance.
3. The wording on the notice shall be as follows:

Additional Terms and Condition for dealers :

1. The licence holder shall:
 - (1) Must have an approved licenced premises for holding animals.
 - (2) Must have appropriate means to transport the category of Wildlife listed.
 - (3) Must keep a register of number and species and categories of animals purchase, sold.
 - (4) Pay all fees as determined by the Wildlife Management Authority.
 - (5) Submit medical examination report every six (6) months.
 - (6) Adhere to open and close season for trapping as advice or published by the Wildlife Division.

2. The Authority reserves the right to alter, revoke or otherwise punish any breach of any terms of this licence, the regulations or any other legal requirements.

Additional Terms and Conditions.

- 1. The licence holder shall
 - (1) Refrain from selling, assigning or transferring quotas assigned by the Wildlife Authority under this licence.
 - (2) Inform the Wildlife Authority of any species for which no market is identified before the end of October 31st.
 - (3) Must have an approved licenced premises for holding animals
 - (4) Must have appropriate means to transport the category of Wildlife listed.
 - (5) Must keep a register of number and species and categories of animals purchase, sold, exported.
 - (6) Pay all fees and levies as determined by the Wildlife Management Authority.
 - (7) Submit medical examination report every six (6) months.
