### CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY

#### Invitation to Submit Memoranda and to give Oral Evidence

A Constituent Assembly consisting of all the Members of the National Assembly has been established by the National Assembly to prepare for the Republic of Guyana, a new Constitution designed to ensure social and economic justice for all of the people of Guyana.

To assist it in its deliberations, the Constituent Assembly will consider views submitted by members of the public and organisations.

All members of the public and organisations who are therefore interested in submitting views for the Constituent Assembly's consideration are hereby invited to do so. Memoranda must be submitted to reach the Secretary not later than 31st January, 1979.

Those who wish to appear before the Constituent Assembly to give oral evidence only or in support of any memorandum submitted must convey their request in writing to the Secretary to reach him not later than 31st January, 1979.
