ORDER DESIGNATING AREA A STATE MINING RESERVE

Notice is hereby given for general information that the undermentioned area is now declared a state mining reserve and is open for exploitation by the Guyana Geology & Mines Commission and persons duly authorised by the said Commission

A tract of state land including the bed and 30.48 metres inland from either bank of the Essequibo River commencing from a point approximately 24 kilometres upriver from the confluence of the Essequibo and Mazaruni Rivers at Wineperu Village thence upriver for a distance of approximately 220 kilometres to Kurupukari Village, thus extending through Mining Districts 2, 3 and 6 and including an area of approximately 40 466 hectares, save and except all lands lawfully occupied or held under title.
