NOTICE APPOINTING DAY ON WHICH LISTS OF CANDIDATES FOR
REGIONAL ELECTIONS MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE
CHIEF ELECTION OFFICER

WHEREAS the President has under article 73 (2) of the Constitution appointed the 16th December, 1991, as the day on which elections of members of Regional Democratic Councils shall be held;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 9 of the Representation of the People Act, Cap. 1:03, (as applied to regional elections by section 18 of Local Democratic Organs Act 1980) that the Elections Commission shall by notice published in the *Gazette* appoint a day being a day not later than 32nd day before election day on which list of candidates may be submitted to the Chief Election Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, TAKE NOTICE that the Elections Commission DO HEREBY APPOINT 14TH November, 1991, as the day on which list candidates as aforesaid may be submitted to the Chief Election Officer.

2. The Chief Election Officer will attend the City Hall, High and Reel Streets, Georgetown in the County of Demerara between the hour of 4 and 6 o'clock in the afternoon of the 14th November, 1991, to receive the lists.
