

NOTICE**THE ROADS ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 277**

WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 18 of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer has caused to be deposited at the office of the District Engineer, Triumph, in the County of Demerara, a Notice accompanied by a plan showing the proposed widening and deviation of parts of the existing road between Subryanville, Georgetown at station 110 + 00, and Buxton, East Coast, Demerara at station 530 + 00, a distance of 7.954 miles and has advertised the deposit of such notice and the general purport thereof in the Gazette of the 27th March, 3rd April and 10th April, 1972.

AND WHEREAS no objection to the proposed widening and deviation of the road aforesaid has been delivered to the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer in accordance with subsection (2) of the said section.

NOW THEREFORE, notice is hereby given that in accordance with subsection (3) of the said section, the President in pursuance of the powers vested in him by such subsection and of all other powers enabling him thereunto, has determined that the said road shall be widened and deviated to the extent proposed aforesaid.
