NOTICE

THE ROADS ACT, CHAPTER 51:01

WHEREAS by Sub-section 1 of Section 18 of the Roads Act, Chapter 51:01 the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer has caused to be deposited at the Office of the Chief Engineer, Roads, Ministry of Works and Housing, Kingston, Georgetown, in the County of Demerara, a notice accompanied by a plan showing the proposed widening and deviation of part of the East Bank Demerara Public Road between Eccles and Brickery, East Bank Demerara, commencing from a point on the centre line of the East Bank, Demerara Public Road at Eccles, at a distance of 455 feet north of the centre line of the Drainage Canal between Eccles and Bagotstown, measured along the centre line of the said Public Road, the said point being at Station 115 + 00 and extending in a southerly direction, generally along the said Public Road to Station 676 + 00 at Brickery, East Bank Demerara for a distance of 10,39 miles, as shown on a plan No. R S. 117 and has advertised the deposit of such notice and the general purport thereof in the Official Gazette of 10th, 17th, and 24th August, 1974.

AND WHEREAS no objection to the proposed widening and deviation of the said road has been delivered to the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer in accordance with Sub-Section 2 of the said Section.

NOW THEREFORE notice is hereby given that in accordance with Sub-section 3 of the said Section, the Minister in pursuance of the powers vested in him by such Sub-section and all other powers enabling him thereunto, has determined that the said road shall be widened and deviated to the extent aforesaid.
