NOTICE

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL ON THE 1ST DAY OF JUNE, 1967, DEPUTED THE BANK OF GUYANA TO EXERCISE ON HIS BEHALF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY SUBSECTIONS (1) AND (2) OF SECTION 3 OF THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ORDINANCE, 1958, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:—

That the delegation of powers mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor-General.

2. That the exercise of any power delegated herein shall be subject to any direction, either general or particular, which the Governor-General may from time to time give in that respect.
