British Guiana (Constitution) Orders, 1961 to 1964.

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY TO MINISTERS

It is announced for general information that the Governor, in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph (1) of article 33 of the Constitution of British Guiana, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Premier, has charged the Ministers mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to this Notice with responsibility for the matters or groups of matters set out against their respective names in the second column of that Schedule and with responsibility for the Departments of Government set out against their respective names in the third column of that Schedule, with effect from the dates set out against their respective names in the fifth column of that Schedule.

It is also announced that the Governor, acting as aforesaid and in accordance with the advice of the Premier, has designated the style by which each such Minister shall be known as set out against their respective names in the fourth column of the Schedule.
