THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE

(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR ON THE 11TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1965, DEPUTED THE MINISTER FOR THE TIME BEING CHARGED WITH THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO EXERCISE ON HIS BEHALF THE POWERS SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE HEREUNDER AND CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE GEORGETOWN SEWERAGE AND WATER ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 153, MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATION:—

THAT THE DELEGATION OF POWERS MENTIONED HEREIN SHALL REMAIN IN FORCE ONLY UNTIL VARIED OR REVOKED BY THE GOVERNOR.
