NOTICE

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE

(Chapter 5)

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR DELEGATED WITH EFFECT FROM THE 20TH JULY, 1965, THE POWER SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN OF THE SCHEDULE HEREUNDER CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN OF THE SAID SCHEDULE TO THE PERSON MENTIONED IN THE THIRD COLUMN THEREOF, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATION:—

That the delegation of the powers mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor.

2. The delegation of the powers mentioned herein to the Commissioner of Local Government or in his absence, the Deputy Commissioner of Local Government on the 22nd June, 1959, is revoked.

SCHEDULE

Power delegated	Ordinance	Officer
To direct removal to an institution for treatment or care, and their discharge or removal back to prison on recovery, of prisoners who are of unsound mind or suffering from communicable disease or disabled.	The Prisons Ordinance, 1957* (Sections 28, 29 and 30).	The Permanent Secretary, or in his absence, the Principal Assistant Secretary of the Ministry responsible for Prisons.
2. To direct that released prisoners notify their addresses to the Police.	The Prisons Ordinance, 1957 (Section 50).	The Permanent Secretary, or in his absence, the Principal Assistant Secretary of the Ministry responsible for Prisons.
