INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR ON THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1965, DEPUTED THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO EXERCISE ON HIS BEHALF THE POWERS CONFERRED ON THE GOVERNOR BY SECTION 5(6) (b) OF THE CIVIL LAW OF BRITISH GUIANA ORDINANCE, SUBJECT HOWEVER TO THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:—

1. That the power delegated herein shall be exercised only in respect of estates of deceased persons not exceeding two thousand five hundred dollars.
2. That the delegation of power mentioned herein shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor.
