REGULATIONS 1968

The following new Electricity Tariffs have been approved by the Guyana Electricity Corporation on 29th March, 1968:

SCHEDULE NO. 1: GEORGETOWN AREA**DOMESTIC TARIFF**

APPLICATION:	Private residence.				
SERVICE:	Single phase 115 volts, 2-wire (Maximum entrance fuse 25 amps.) 230 volts, 2-wire 115/230 volts, 3-wire.

SCHEDULE NO. 2: GEORGETOWN AREA**SMALL POWER TARIFF**

- APPLICATION:** Premises (other than private residences) to which no other tariff applies.
- SERVICE:** 115/230 volts, 3-wire, single phase
Large installations and three phase would be by special arrangement.
- MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGE:** \$2.00 per KVA (or part thereof) of Billing Demand.
- MONTHLY ENERGY CHARGE:** First 100 KWH/KVA of Billing Demand @ 10c. each
Next 200 " " " " " " @ 6c. "
Excess " " " " " " @ 5c. "
- MONTHLY MINIMUM CHARGE:** THE SERVICE CHARGE
- DEPOSIT:** Equivalent to two months' estimated billing.
Minimum: \$25.00
- FUEL PRICE VARIATION CLAUSE:** Every bill for energy supplied at this tariff (including the Service Charge) shall be increased by one percent (1%) for each fifty cents (50c.), or part thereof greater than twenty-five cents (25c.), by which the average fuel cost per ton in the preceding month exceeded nineteen dollars (\$19.00).

SCHEDULE NO. 3: GEORGETOWN AREA**LARGE POWER TARIFF**

- APPLICATION:** Premises (other than private residences) with a minimum **CONNECTED MOTOR LOAD** of 25 KVA.
- SERVICE:** 115/230 volts, 3-wire, single phase and/or three phase where available.
- MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGE:** \$2.00 per KVA (or part thereof) of Billing Demand.
- MONTHLY ENERGY CHARGE:** First 100 KWH/KVA of Billing Demand @ 7c. each
 Next 100 " " " " " " @ 5c. "
 Excess " " " " " " @ 3c. "
- MONTHLY MINIMUM CHARGE:** THE SERVICE CHARGE.
- PRIMARY VOLTAGE SUPPLY:** A discount of five percent (5%) of any bill paid within fifteen (15) days of the issue thereof will be allowed to any consumer who accepts a supply at a primary voltage (provided that the net amount of any bill, after deducting the discount, shall not be less than the Monthly Service Charge).
- DEPOSIT:** Equivalent to two months' estimated billing.
- FUEL PRICE VARIATION CLAUSE:** Every bill for energy supplied at this tariff (including the Service Charge) shall be increased by one percent (1%) for each fifty cents (50c.), or part thereof greater than twenty-five cents (25c.), by which the average fuel cost per ton in the preceding month exceeded nineteen dollars (\$19.00).

SCHEDULE NO. 6: RURAL AREA**LARGE POWER TARIFF**

APPLICATION: Premises (other than private residences) with a minimum CONNECTED MOTOR LOAD of 25 KVA.

SERVICE: 240 volts, 2-wire, or 240/480 volts, 3-wire, single phase.
415 volts, 4-wire, three phase (if available).

MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGE: \$2.00 per kVA (or part thereof) of Billing Demand.

MONTHLY ENERGY CHARGE: First 100 KWH/KVA of Billing Demand @ 8c. each
Next 100 " " " " " @ 6c. "
Excess @ 4c. "

MONTHLY MINIMUM CHARGE: THE SERVICE CHARGE.

PRIMARY VOLTAGE SUPPLY: A discount of five percent (5%) of any bill paid within fifteen (15) days of the issue thereof will be allowed to any consumer who accepts a supply at a primary voltage (provided that the net amount of any bill, after deducting the discount, shall not be less than the Monthly Service Charge).

DEPOSIT: Equivalent to two months' estimated billing.

FUEL PRICE VARIATION CLAUSE: Every bill for energy supplied at this tariff (including the Service Charge) shall be increased by one percent (1%) for each fifty cents (50c.), or part thereof greater than twenty-five cents (25c.), by which the average fuel cost per ton in the preceding month exceeded nineteen dollars (\$19.00).

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of the Corporation's tariffs:

“average fuel cost per ton in the preceding month” in relation to any bill for energy supplied means the average price per long ton net weight for the Bunker ‘C’ fuel oil delivered to the Corporation in the calendar month preceding the month in which the relevant meter reading (that is the meter reading upon which the bill is based) was made, or, if no such oil was delivered to the Corporation in such calendar month, in the next preceding calendar month in which such oil was so delivered; and the certificate of the Chairman, Deputy Chairman, General Manager or Secretary of the Corporation as to whether or not any such oil was delivered to the Corporation in any month and as to the average price of the oil so delivered in any month shall be conclusive;

“Billing Demand” in relation to any supply for any month means —

- (1) in the case of a supply having a Connected Load of less than 25 KVA, the Connected Load as notified to and assessed by the Corporation, and
- (2) in the case of a supply having a Connected Load of 25 KVA or more, four times the greatest consumption (measured in kilovolt-amperes) registered by the Corporation's meter in respect of such supply in any period of fifteen minutes in any of the twelve months up to and including that month, except that for any month in the first eleven months during which a supply is provided to a consumer the Billing Demand shall be four times the greatest consumption registered as above in any period of fifteen minutes in any month up to and including that month, the maximum demand may be measured in kilovolt-amperes or kilowatts at the option of the Corporation and if it is measured in kilowatts it shall be converted into kilovolt-amperes by dividing the kilowatt figure by a conversion factor of 0.85;

“Bunker ‘C’ fuel oil means boiler fuel of minimum gross calorific value of 18,000 B.Th.U. per lb. with viscosity, Saybolt universal seconds at 100°F not exceeding 4,100 secs. and Sulphur content not exceeding 2.2% by weight;

“Connected Load” means the aggregate rating in kilovolt-amperes of all electrical apparatus on the premises (provided that the rating for lighting apparatus shall be one kilovolt-ampere or the actual rating of the lighting apparatus on the premises, whichever is the greater) and for the purpose of calculating the rating in kilovolt-amperes, the rating in kilowatts shall be divided by a conversion factor of 0.85;

“Connected Motor Load” means the aggregate rating in kilovolt-amperes of the electric motors (other than motors having a rating of less than one kilovolt-ampere) and electric welding apparatus, and any other appliance which the Corporation may in its discretion accept as being equivalent to a motor for the purposes of this definition, connected to the supply in question and in use; and for the purpose of calculating the rating in kilovolt-amperes, the rating, in kilowatts shall be divided

by a conversion factor of 0.85;

“Georgetown area” means the city of Georgetown as defined by the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance and the environs of the said city within a distance of five miles of the limits thereof excluding any part of the said environs which was not supplied with energy by the Corporation at 31st December, 1962; and the certificate of the Chairman, Deputy Chairman, General Manager or Secretary of the Corporation as to whether or not any part of the said environs was supplied at 31st December, 1962, shall be conclusive;

“KVA” means kilovolt-ampere;

“KW” means kilowatt;

“KWH” means kilowatt hour;

“month” means a period of approximately one month between one normal meter reading and the next;

“primary voltage” means 4000 volts or more;

“rural areas” means all areas not forming part of the Georgetown area as defined above;

“unit” means kilowatt-hour; and

the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa.
