

NOTICE

UNDER THE ROADS ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 277

WHEREAS by subsection (1) of section 18 of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer has caused to be deposited at the District Engineer's Office, Canje, Berbice, a Notice accompanied by plans of Project No. 5 G, Drawings Nos. ARS 411/1-16, showing the proposed widening and deviation of part of the existing road between Princess Elizabeth Road, at its junction with Vryheid Street, New Amsterdam, and No. 31 Village also known as Cheswick, Corentyne, and has advertised the deposit of such Notice and the general purport thereof in the Gazette on the 30th December, 1967, and the 6th and 13th January, 1968;

AND WHEREAS no objection to the proposed widening and deviation of the road aforesaid has been delivered to the Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer in accordance with subsection (2) of the said section:

NOW THEREFORE, notice is hereby given in accordance with sub-section (3) of the said section that the Governor-General, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by such subsection and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, has determined that the said road shall be widened and deviated as and to the extent proposed as aforesaid.

Notice No. 581 C, which purported to publish the determination of the widening and deviation of parts of the existing road between Princess Elizabeth Road at its junction with Vryheid Street, New Amsterdam and No. 31 Village also known as Cheswick, Corentyne, dated 4th June, 1968 and published in the Gazette on 15th June, 1968, is hereby revoked.
