THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE

(Chapter 5)

UNDER SECTION 39 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 5, THE POWERS SPECIFIED IN THE FIRST COLUMN CONFERRED BY THE ORDINANCE MENTIONED IN THE SECOND COLUMN HAVE BEEN DELEGATED BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR TO THE OFFICER MENTIONED IN THE THIRD COLUMN.

1. To authorise the Financial Secretary to pay out sums certified by the Registrar in respect of claims to the proceeds of execution sales.	The Supreme Court Ordinance, Chapter 7. (Section 72 excluding the proviso thereto).	The Chief Secretary.
2. To appoint a fit and proper person to be the Registration Officer of Amerindians and such assistant registration officers for such parts of the Colony as he may think fit.	The Amerindian Ordinance, Chapter 58. (Section 7).	The Chief Secretary.
3. To approve of the appointment, or the revocation of the appointment, of any Amerindian he may think fit to be Captain of any District Area or Village.	The Amerindian Ordinance, Chapter 58. (Section 14(1)).	The Chief Secretary.
4. To direct the manner in which the Amerindian Purpose Fund shall be expended.	The Amerindian Ordinance, Chapter 58. (Section 28).	The Chief Secretary.
5. To appoint, in his discretion any male minister of the Christian religion ordained, or otherwise set apart, to the ministry of that religion according to the usage of the communion to which he belongs to be a marriage officer for the Colony.	The Marriage Ordinance, Chapter 164. (Section 4 (1)).	The Chief Secretary.
6. To appoint any District Commissioner or other Officer to be superintendent registrar of marriages in a marriage district.	The Marriage Ordinance, Chapter 164. (Section 15).	The Chief Secretary.
7. To declare at any time any building a superintendent registrar's office.	The Marriage Ordinance, Chapter 164. (Section 19).	The Chief Secretary.
8. To grant a licence to marry without publication of banns if he think fit in any case.	The Marriage Ordinance, Chapter 164. (Section 38).	The Chief Secretary
